Planning Considerations - What hardscaping are we to do?

- 1.→ Budget: Determine the funds available for your project. To compute budget dollars for our products see the following steps. Naturally you will need to add labor and other materials, not addressed herein.
- 2.→ Survey Your Yard and determine what features you would like to add or modify. This could be driveways, walkways, block fencing, retaining walls, fire pit, barbeque, raised planters, tree beds, etc.
- 3.→ Product: Function often determines thickness. Pick out specific products suitable for your project:
 - For Fence Wall: Pick type (Slump or CMU), Size, Texture(Smooth, Split face, Shot Blast) and Color.
 - For Retaining Wall: load consideration = suitable product, texture and color.
 - For Pavers: paver thickness, a paver for the border, field pattern and colors.
 - Residential driveway pavers need to be a minimum of 2 3/8" thick (60mm) and require stricter installation procedures.
 - For paver border (soldier course) most often used are Hollands, or 6x9 or 6x6 Cobbles.

The Following pavers are suitable for driveways and patios

Aztex, Cobble 3x6, Cobble 6x6, Cobble 6x9, Cobble 9x9, Tumbled Cobbles, Decora, Mini Diamond, Pentagon, Holland and I Pavers.

The Following pavers are suitable for walkways and patios. Not to be used for a driveway! Gecko Stones, Spanish Tile, 6x2x12 smooth, 8x 1 5/8 x 16 smooth, 12x12 smooth, 16x2x12 Cobble Face, 16x16 smooth, 16x16 Brick Face, 16x2x16 Cobble Stone.

For Flagstone: pick thickness, color.

Go to CABCOAZ.COM for more information, including an estimating outline work sheet.

Hint: All sizes are approximate. You do not have to purchase by the pallet except tumbled cobbles. All other products are sold by the piece, not per the square foot. Due to difficulty of printing true colors, pick color from an actual sample, not this flyer. Expect some color variance, due to different production lots, temperature, humidity, aggregate and concrete color variations. As such, try to buy all product in complete area sections.

Planning Considerations - Whose doing the work?

- A) Next determine whether you are installing yourself, or going to have it professionally done. While pavers lend themselves to being installed by do it yourselfers, we recommend professional installation for drive ways, complex patterns, or projects that require a lot of cuts. Mortared masonry, flagstone and projects such as built in barbeques are best left to professionals.
- **B)** If doing it yourself, determine the rough quantities of materials needed and get pricing. If within budget, finalize the materials. If multiple deliveries are needed, stage deliveries as the materials will be needed. If over budget, perhaps look at doing sections, like wall first, then later pavers. See below for estimating.
- **C)** If having it done, we would suggest getting a minimum of 2 quotes from reputable contractors or landscapers.

Planning Considerations - If you are doing the work.

→ Estimate Rough Quantities:

For Walls, you need length and height and width of block. To estimate for 4" high block, multiply length in feet x height x 2.25. For 8" high block multiply length in feet x height x 1.15.

For Retaining Walls, you need length and height of project. Choose a product, some have caps some don't. For structural, not ornamental, the first course should be buried, per engineering, half way, so add that to your quantity. Cap quantity is length in feet of project x 12, divided by cap length in inches. For most installations retaining 3 feet or less of earth no permit is required.

For Pavers you need to start with square footage (length x width). If no border, take square footage times number of pavers required to make a square foot. However, most paver installations use a paver border to enhance the field pattern. If so, take perimeter in feet x 12, then divide by edge length of the soldier coarse paver, to determine number of pavers needed for border. Now take that number times the number of border pavers to make a square foot for that paver type, which equals border paver square footage. Now take total square footage & subtract the border square footage, from the total, to determine the square footage remaining for the field. Choose your field paver and multiply it's pieces per square foot by field square footage. Some field patterns will require more cuts, so these are minimum quantities.

Planning Considerations - Pattern choices Cobbles

Two of the most popular patterns for cobbles using just 6x6 & 6x9 sizes are the K pattern (which uses approximately one (6x6) to two (6x9) & a running bond (which uses a one to one blend of 6x6 and 6x9), or just 6x9's. For a one of a kind look, consider using a random pattern utilizing 3 or 4 different size cobbles. For a 3 size mix we suggest starting with a 10, 35, 55 percentage ratio of square feet, using 3x6, 6x6 and 6x9. For a 4 size mix we suggest starting with a 5,35,50,10 percentage ratio, small→large.

Cobble> "K" Pattern 6x6 and 6x9




3 unit Random Cobble> using 3x6,6x6,6x9,



For most pavers you must decide upon a pattern. You can also use color changes as a pattern. The pattern you choose affects the quantity of each size needed and will also determine the difficulty of laying, since some patterns will require more cuts for edging than other patterns. There is almost an endless array of patterns. Please see our website www.cabcoaz.com for additional information, such as patterns and a paver calculator.

Some of the more common patterns using Holland pavers are the running bond, herringbone and basket weave.



5.→ Planning Considerations -Paver Colors: Most of our pavers come in a Two-Tone Brown blend, Tierra blend, or a Red & Black blend. Cobbles have an additional 3 colors of Canyon, Pueblo and Buff blends for a total of 6 colors. Tumbled cobbles have two additional colors, Copper Blend & Buff Blend. Please pic color by samples. Other colors are available as a special order. We have seen installations combining two of these mixes for a unique color variation (as above).

Quick Installation Guide- Soils, Border & Footer, Base & Bedding

Paver pavements are only as good as the base upon which they are laid. The quality of your soil on site and anticipated use will determine how much excavation will be required for a structural sub-base and sand bedding. Obviously much more soil preparation and installation procedures are involved for a drive way vs pedestrian loads. All paver installations require a stable outer edge to keep pavers in place, with or without a border pattern. Often border edge pavers are a different type or laid in a different pattern than the field. Your outer border pavers (soldier coarse) needs to be anchored, so the pavers will not be able to spread. This is often partially achieved by laying against an existing structural border like a house pad or concrete side walk. For the remaining borders, especially driveway entry, a concrete footer that is a few inches wider than the pavers chosen for the soldier coarse, is poured on the outer edges, then mortaring those border pavers on top of the concrete footer. However in many applications Snap-Edge® paver restraints may also be used. See more about them on page 13.







Quick Installation Guide - Paver Placement

There are 3 ways to place pavers: mortar less, dry mortar, and wet mortar. For the non-professional, we suggest mortar less or dry mortar. For mortar less paving on *pedestrian* walkways or patios, on existing quality soil, we recommend 1"to 1-1/2" of washed sand, be placed over the compacted subgrade and screeded smooth to the proper elevation required. On driveways, for best results, we would suggest a subgrade of 4" of compacted ABC, then sand, and pavers should be vibrated during sanding the joints. (See ICPI recommendations on internet) A layer of plastic sheeting (non permeable application) or landscaping fabric may be placed over the sand to provide a smoother bed for the pavers. Next, place the pavers close together (1/16 to 1/8 inch) in the pattern of choice, leaving a space for sand. Pavers should be taken from a **minimum of two pallets, working off pallets top to bottom, not by row**. Be sure sand lugs are engaged between adjoining pavers, other wise chipping is likely to occur. After placing the pavers, spread a fine dry sand over them and sweep thoroughly to fill the joints, this will require several applications. We recommend a sealer be applied a month or two after installation and after all joints are resanded. This helps hold color, makes spills easier to clean and helps prevent ant hills.

Most chipping is due to improper installation, driveway pavers must be installed per International Concrete Paver Institute guidelines



General Retaining Wall Information

(additional information is available for all retaining wall products upon request)

Quantity:

Determine a rough quantity of units needed by starting at the lowest elevation and determine line, length and height of wall. Measure the length & height of your wall including how much will be buried below grade. On walls 3 feet high and under, bury ½ of a unit. If incorporating a cap block, figure cap block sq.ft. by taking the length of wall divided by 3. Cap quantity is length of wall divided by width of cap block you are using. Compute the total wall sq. ft. and subtract the cap block sq. ft. Divide that by square feet per piece of product you are using, to get number of wall units required. With good non-sandy or excessive clay soils, no import or abc is needed. A gravel bed is recommended 4" to 6" thick and gravel is also recommended to fill the cells for both drainage and interlocking. Generally an 18" wide trench is satisfactory. To compute gravel needed for the trench (1/2"-3/4" crushed is preferred), multiply length of wall x 1.5' and divide by 3 to get cubic feet required. Per unit of 6" stonewall 12 blocks requires 1 cubic foot of fill, for 8" Stonewall it is 9 blocks per cubic foot. Divide cubic feet by 27 to get cyds.

How high can Stone Wall be built? Walls less than 3 feet high, without excessive loads generally require no geogrid reinforcement. Walls over 3 feet high generally require terracing and/or an engineered design utilizing reinforcement. Consult your local building codes or seek professional assistance.

Construction: Order products and call Blue Stake before digging to insure no utilities are present. After Blue Stake inspects, set level string line & dig a trench 6" to 8" deep (depending upon height of retaining block) and 18" wide. Compact trench, place 4" of compacted gravel along trench bottom, be sure to make it level. Place a level string line along length of wall face. Install first course of blocks, 1/2 should be below ground level. Check for level, both side to side and front to back. Place Stonewall pins in the top of the placed course, lightly tap into place. If pin channel is not clean, tap out any obstruction with a punch before placing pin. Fill between and behind blocks with gravel. Brush any excess gravel from the top of the blocks. Lay next course overlapping the joint between the two blocks below. To make 1/2 blocks, score top and bottom with cold chisel and break or cut with a masonry saw. Continue leveling from side to side and front to back, and compact gravel behind and between the blocks. On final cap course, determine wedge or square cap block and place over pins. If using as a bench we recommend also using an outdoor adhesive.




